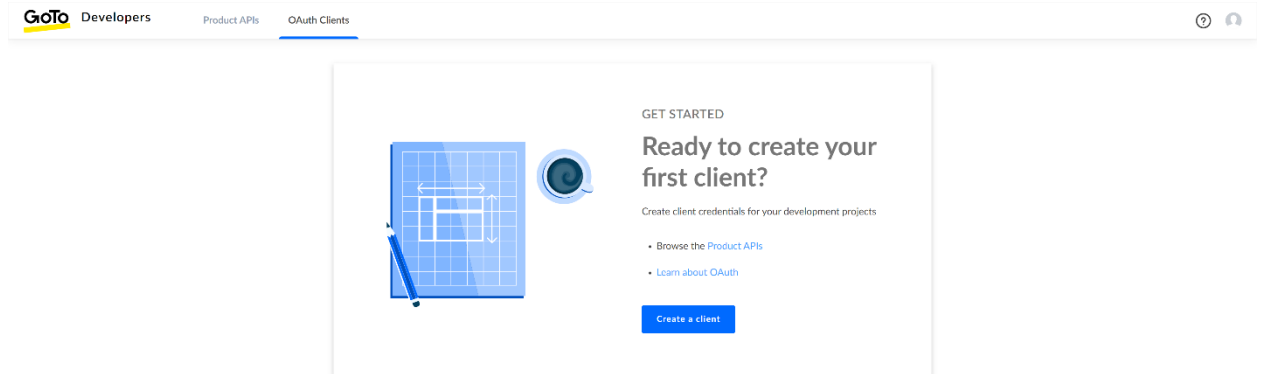


GoToMeeting connector for Creatio set-up guide.

1. Log in in your GoTo account

2. Open GoTo OAuth clients manager in browser (<https://developer.logmeininc.com/clients>)



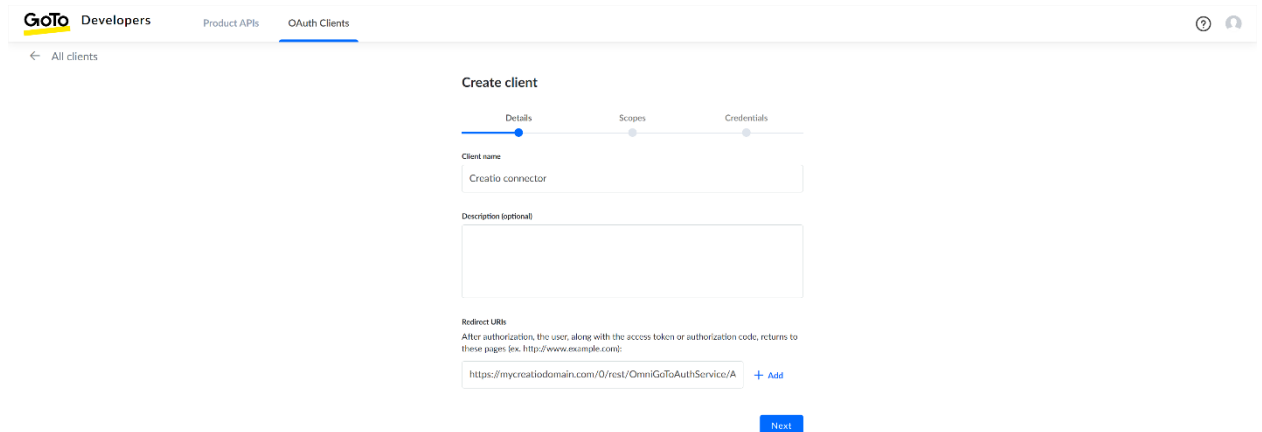
3. Create new client\

Set any client name (for example, Creatio connector)

Paste new Redirect URI and click Add.

Redirect URI template: [YOUR_CREATIO_ADRESS]/0/rest/OmniGoToAuthService/AuthCallback

Example: <https://mycreatiomain.com/0/rest/OmniGoToAuthService/AuthCallback>



4. In Scopes list, tick the GoToMeeting option

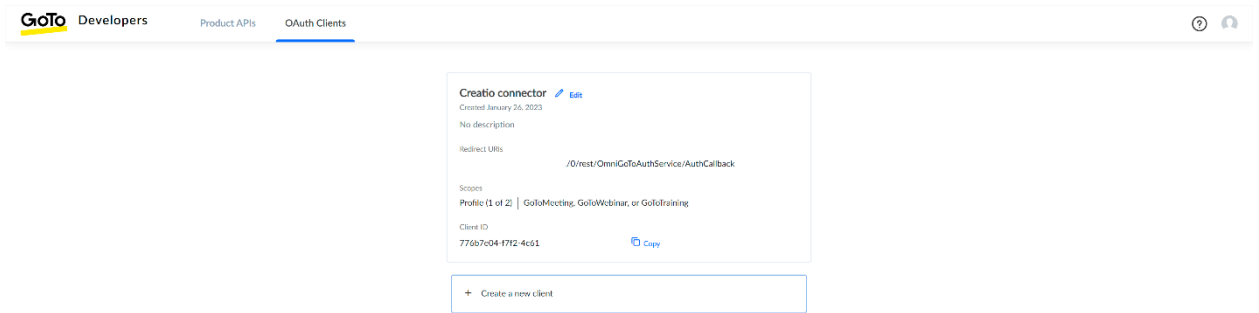
