
How to create a Telegram bot

- 1. Follow these steps to register a new bot in Telegram:
 - 1.1. Find @BotFather on Telegram.




BotFather is the main bot designed to manage the rest of the bots. Use it to register a new bot or configure already created ones.

1.2. Press 'Start' to start BotFather and a dialogue




Note: The text that appears before clicking "Start" is a description of the bot. You can also configure it using BotFather's special command - /setdescription. BotFather will display a welcome message with a list of commands that you can use after clicking "Start".



1.3. Send /newbot command to the BotFather



- 1.4. You can send commands to the bot in several ways:
 - 1.4.1. Click the command in the message.
 - 1.4.2. Type "/" in text box to see a list of available commands and select one from the list.
 - 1.4.3. Send a message with the command
- 1.5. Give your bot the name and username.




The name of your bot will be shown in the bot contact info.

You can always change it with /setname command.

@username is used for fast search in Telegram and profile links like t.me/username.

Username can contain letters, underscores, numbers and can be from 5 to 32 characters long and should end with "bot" (e.g. @username_bot or @UsernameBot)

1.6. Save token



After you create the name and username you'll get a message from a BotFather with API token and a link to your bot.

If you lost this token or it was stolen, use /token command and create a new one.
